

GDA Young Talent Award 2024

for bachelor's theses, master's theses, doctoral theses and other student work + special prize "Sustainable Datacenters".

With the Young Talent Award, GDA is explicitly looking for talents who want to contribute to the digitalization of tomorrow: Outstanding bachelor's, master's and doctoral theses as well as other student work in the field of data centers and digital infrastructures are each awarded 1,500 euros or 2,500 euros.

Young IT talents compete with their smart ideas

Entries can be submitted in the fields of energy & sustainability, hardware & software, innovation and cross-cutting issues - the spectrum is as diverse as the data center and digital infrastructure industry itself. Due to the particular importance of the topic for the industry, GDA is also offering a special award for "Sustainable Datacenters". This will be selected from all categories.

Eligible for the award are works through which progress can be made for the field of digitalization and data centers.

Independent jury of experts

The award winners are selected by an independent jury of experts headed by GDA board member Prof. Dr. Peter Radgen (University of Stuttgart).

The submitted papers must be completed between 1 August 2023 and 31 July 2024. They can be written in German or English.

The deadline for applications is 25 August 2024.
